

The Future at the Yorkshire School of Christian Ministry

We have established a rolling programme of teaching and training which now involves two tracks each year.

We are particularly looking at areas where there will either be great benefit from co-operating with a number of other churches, or where our individual churches may struggle to put on courses alone, but which are feasible when we work together in the gospel. We aim to cover a wide range of practical and relevant issues.

Each course involves monthly tutorials on a Monday evening for nine months in conjunction with home assignments.
